## 1st Singapore Sports School Junior Tenpin Bowling Championships 11<sup>th</sup> March to 15<sup>th</sup> March 2008

### 1. OBJECTIVES & SANCTION

- 1.1 This Tournament is organised by Singapore Sports School, the purpose of this Tournament is to promote bowling among Primary & Secondary School, besides fostering and maintaining the spirit of good fellowship and true sportsmanship among students and sanctioned by SBF.
- 1.2 This Tournament will be held from 11<sup>th</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup> March 2008 and will be held in Singapore Sports School Bowling Centre.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 Primary School (age 10 Yrs to 12 Yrs)
- 2.2 Secondary School (Age 13 Yrs to 14 Yrs)

### 3. PLAYING RULES

- 3.1 As this Tournament is sanctioned by SBF, WTBA Playing rules and regulations shall apply on matters not covered here in.

### 4. CLASSIFICATION / FORMAT / SQUAD

#### 4.1 Primary Division:

All boys and girls who are in **Primary 4, 5 or 6**, and are 12 years of age, or below, as at 1st January 2008 (born on 1995 or after), are eligible to play in this Boys & Girls division.

This is a singles event and is open to the first 60 bowlers (Boys & Girls) from Under 12 signed and paid up first. They will be combined and divided into 2 Squads of 24 bowlers each. There will be stripping & oiling done everyday before each squad.

#### 4.2 Secondary Division:

All boys and girls who are in **Secondary 1 or 2**, and are 14 years of age, or below, as at 1st January 2008 (born on 1993 or after), are eligible to play in this Boys & Girls division.

This is a singles event and is open to the first 60(Boys & Girls) from Under 14 signed and paid up first. They will be combined and divided into 2 Squads of 24 bowlers each. There will be stripping & oiling done everyday before each squad.

#### 4.3 Identification Card or Passports:

It is the bowlers' duty to bring their identification card or passport for identification upon checking in on their first day of competition.

#### 4.4 Qualifying rounds:

The bowlers will be bowled over 12 games conducted over 2 days and bowled in 2 blocks of 6 games per block.

#### 4.5 Masters Finals:

The Top 24 Bowlers (top 12 Boys & top 12 girls) from Under 12 & Top 24 Bowlers (top 12 Boys & top 12 girls) from Under 14 (based on total pinfalls) after the Qualifying will bowl 8 games in the Masters Finals to determine the overall position standings.

### 5. ENTRIES AND ENTRY FEE

#### 5.1 Under 12 Division:

All entries must be submitted on prescribed forms available. The entry fee for the whole of this Tournament is S\$60.00 per bowler.

#### 5.2 Under 14 Division:

All entries must be submitted on prescribed forms available. The entry fee for the whole of this Tournament is S\$60.00 per bowler.

### 6. CLOSING DATE

**Closing Date is 25th February 2008.** Entries received after the closing date are acceptable subject to availability of Squad. All participants must check-in and have their entry fees fully paid by 5.30pm on 25<sup>th</sup> February 2008, failing which the Tournament Manager or in his absence his appointed official(s) on duty reserves the right to call in bowler(s) on reserve list.

Since this is a singles event and open to 60 bowlers (Boys & Girls) from Under 12 & 60 bowlers (Boys & Girls) from Under 14, entries will be based on a first-come-first-serve basis or the closing date whichever comes first.

### 7. REFUNDS

No refund of entry fees will be made after it has been paid and the entry has been accepted and registered.

### 8. AWARDS

#### 8.1 Under 12 Division:

Trophies will be awarded to the **top 6 bowlers** in Boys & Girls division in this Tournament.

#### 8.2 Under 14 Division:

Trophies will be awarded to the **top 6 bowlers** in Boys & Girls division in this Tournament.

House Awards do not apply throughout the Tournament, unless otherwise stated. There shall be no perfect game award.

### 9. REPORTING TIME

Notwithstanding any delays in the running of the squads, participants must be present for the check-in in person 30 minutes before scheduled time to bowl. The Bowling Centre's Clock shall be the official time piece. Late comers will bowl at the frames/game in which their partners are bowling.

### 10. DRESS CODE

Bowlers are required to be properly and appropriately dressed for their events. If in the opinion of the Tournament Manager or his appointed official on duty a bowler is not properly and appropriately attired, he/she may not be permitted to bowl. In the event of any TV coverage, it is the prerogative of the Tournament Manager to nominate/stipulate the attire to be worn.

### 11. REGISTRATION OF BOWLING BALLS

It is the bowler's responsibility to ensure that all bowling balls used by him/her during the Tournament are verified for correctness of weight and other specifications, conforming to FIQ Rules and Regulations. If in doubt, the bowler may have his/her ball(s) verified by the Tournament Technical Committee. The Tournament Manager or his appointed official on duty reserves the right to recall any bowling ball for inspection at any time. If at any time, the bowler is found to have used an illegal ball, even if previously certified legal by the Tournament

Technical Committee he/she may be disqualified from the entire Tournament and stripped of all his/her winnings or position standings and if the Tournament Committee is of the opinion that such usage was deliberate and with intent to cheat, he/she may be further reported to his / her respective Association / Congress and SBF for additional penalization. He / She may also be asked to return immediately to the Tournament Manager or his appointed official(s) on duty any awards that may have already been given to him / her.

### 12. VERIFICATION OF SCORES

It is the responsibility of each bowler to verify the correctness of each game bowled by signing on the official result sheet which will be used as the official scores recorded. Once signed, the scores shall stand, unless otherwise decided by the Tournament Manager. In the event the official score sheet is not signed, for any reason, the Tournament Manager reserves the right to refuse acceptance of the result sheet.

### 13. PACERS

No pacers will be allowed throughout the Tournament unless appointed by the Tournament Manager or his appointed official on duty.

### 14. TIES

In the event of tie(s) occurring and affecting the:-

#### 14.1 Under 12 Division: (Boys / Girls)

Top 12th position after the qualifying rounds (12 games) the tie(s) shall be determined by a one game roll-off. Should the tie(s) remain, then the 9th and 10th frame roll-off shall be played and repeated, if necessary until the tie(s) is / are broken.

#### 14.2 Under 14 Division: (Boys / Girls)

Top 12th position after the qualifying rounds (12 games) the tie(s) shall be determined by a one game roll-off. Should the tie(s) remain, then the 9th and 10th frame roll-off shall be played and repeated, if necessary until the tie(s) is / are broken.

Should a tie occur in any of the other positions involving a difference in prizes, a 9th and 10th frame roll-off shall be played and repeated until the tie(s) is/are broken.

### 15. TIE-BREAKER SCHEDULE:

15.1 Qualifying Round - Saturday, 15th March 2008

### 16. PROTESTS

#### 16.1 Eligibility:

Protest involving eligibility must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Manager or his appointed official on duty within 24 hours of the time of the alleged infringement.

#### 16.2 Errors in Scoring:

Errors in scoring or errors in calculation will be corrected by the Tournament Officials immediately upon discovery of such errors. Protests involving errors in scoring will only be entertained if such protests are brought to the attention of the Tournament Manager or his appointed official on duty on the spot.

### 16.3 Fouls:

Protest involving fouls must be brought to the attention of the Lane Marshall before the delivery of the next ball. No protest will be entertained after the bowler has made his second delivery of the frame.

All other protests must be made in writing to the Tournament Manager on the spot and/or before the presentation of prizes.

No protests will be entertained after the presentation of prizes.

### 17. \*\*INTERPRETATION CLAUSE

The Tournament Manager or, in his absence, his appointed official on duty reserves the right to accept or reject any entry / ies as he/she deems fit. Any matter arising which is not covered in this Tournament Rules and Regulations will be decided by the Tournament Manager whose decision shall be final subject only to appeal to SBF.
